North Bay Regional Center is one of 21 regional centers throughout the State providing services to persons with developmental disabilities. Specifically, North Bay operates in three counties; Sonoma, Napa, and Solano and both oversees and delivers services to over 8,400 clients. Disabilities range from intellectual disabilities (previously known as mental retardation), cerebral palsy, autism, epilepsy and others.

NBRC is a non-profit corporation contracting with the State of California. We are seeking Board Members who have an interest in helping people with development disabilities develop a better life in their community. The Board, all volunteers, meets monthly for public meetings approximately two hours 5:00-7:00 p.m. Board members may also voluntarily attend monthly Executive Committee meetings for approximately one hour by teleconference or in person. Most meetings are held at NBRC Headquarters in Napa, but at least once a year meetings are held in Sonoma and Solano Counties.

In accordance with our contract and outlined in our bylaws, NBRC is required to have an equal representation on the Board from each of the three counties.
