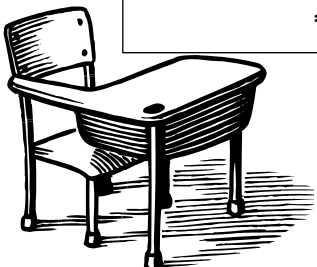
SPEAKER PRESENTATION:
