Behavioral Analysis Services

Behavioral analysis services provide for the design, implementation and evaluation of plans to promote positive behaviors, consistent with evidence based practices.

Behavioral analysis services may be purchased by NBRC through the Individual Program Plan and Individual Family Service Program Plan process. These services shall include the following:

- Selection preference for NBRC vendors, prior to use of out of area resources
- Timely completion of a behavioral assessment.
- Design of an intervention plan with specific targeted goals that is likely to reduce the frequency and intensity of the identified problem behavior(s).
- Inclusion of parent/caregiver participation in the implementation of the interventions
- Plan for fading services over time.
- A review process for monitoring services for efficacy of treatment; progress must be noted to continue services after initial service period.
- Behavior services are therapeutic and treatment oriented. Once efficacy of treatment has been achieved, other less restrictive services/treatment options will be reviewed for consumer/family support.

All generic resources must be exhausted before services are provided.

Services will follow Lanterman Developmental Disabilities Services Act guidelines.

The NBRC Executive Director may review and authorize an exception if warranted by individual circumstances.
