Employment Options

North Bay Regional Center (NBRC) recognizes that work is an important part of an individual's life. It needs to be considered along with his or her needs, desires and ambitions as a whole person. The opportunity to try different employment options should be looked at as a natural part of personal growth.

- Employment services can range from participation in structured work activity programs, Supported Employment Services or competitive employment.
- Support should be made available to people with developmental disabilities to afford the best opportunity to maintain their employment and provide for career development.
- North Bay Regional Center advocates for employment opportunities that will provide challenging integrated work at the highest wages possible.
- North Bay Regional Center advocates for employment opportunities that provide the maximum amount of hours up to full time employment.

All generic resources must be exhausted before services are provided.

All NBRC funded services will follow the Lanterman Developmental Disabilities Service Act guidelines.

The NBRC Executive Director may review and authorize an exception if warranted by individual circumstances.
