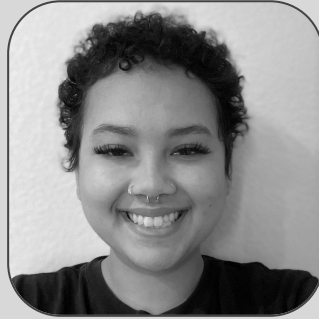

Focus on maintaining safety during critical moments.

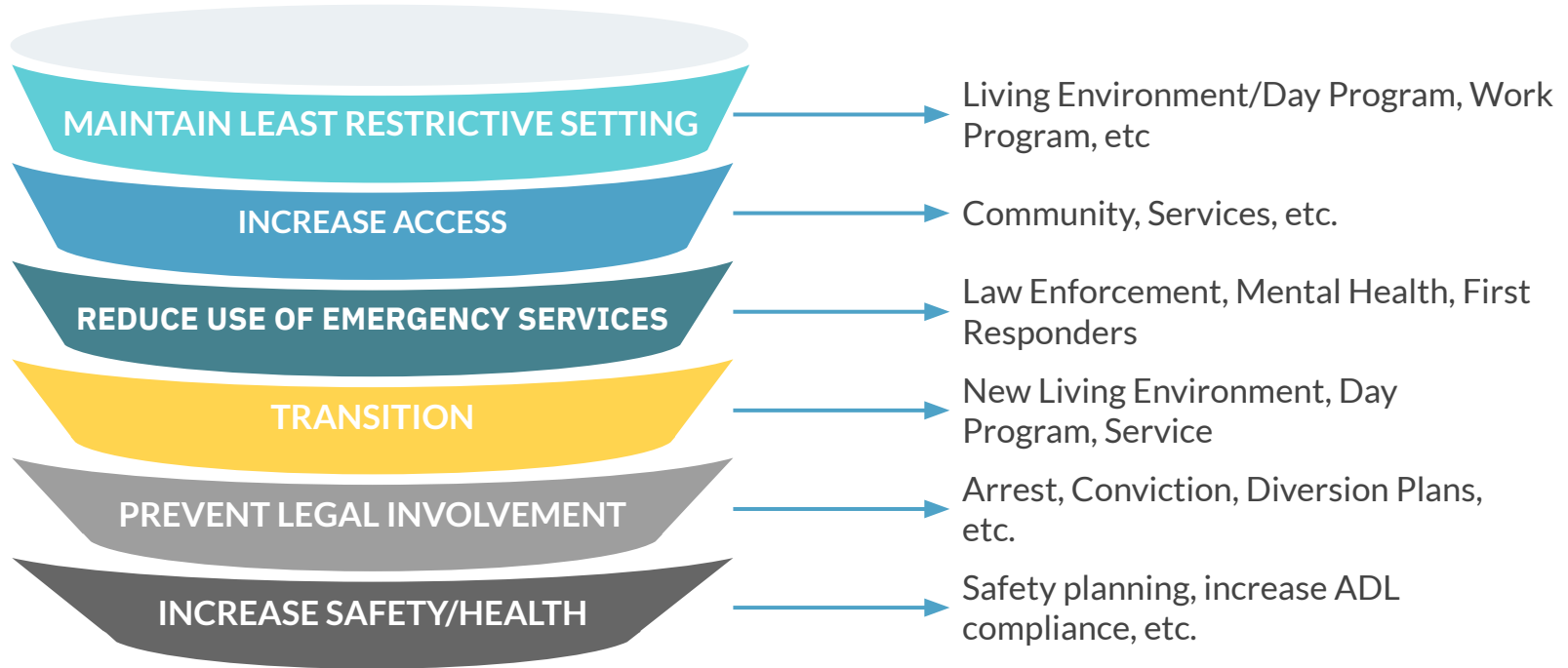
Intervention

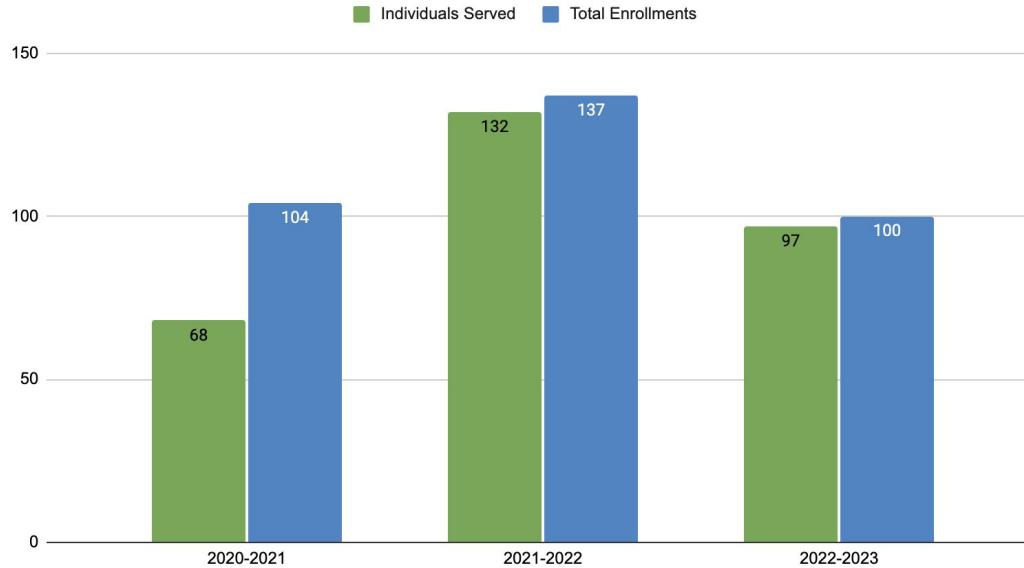

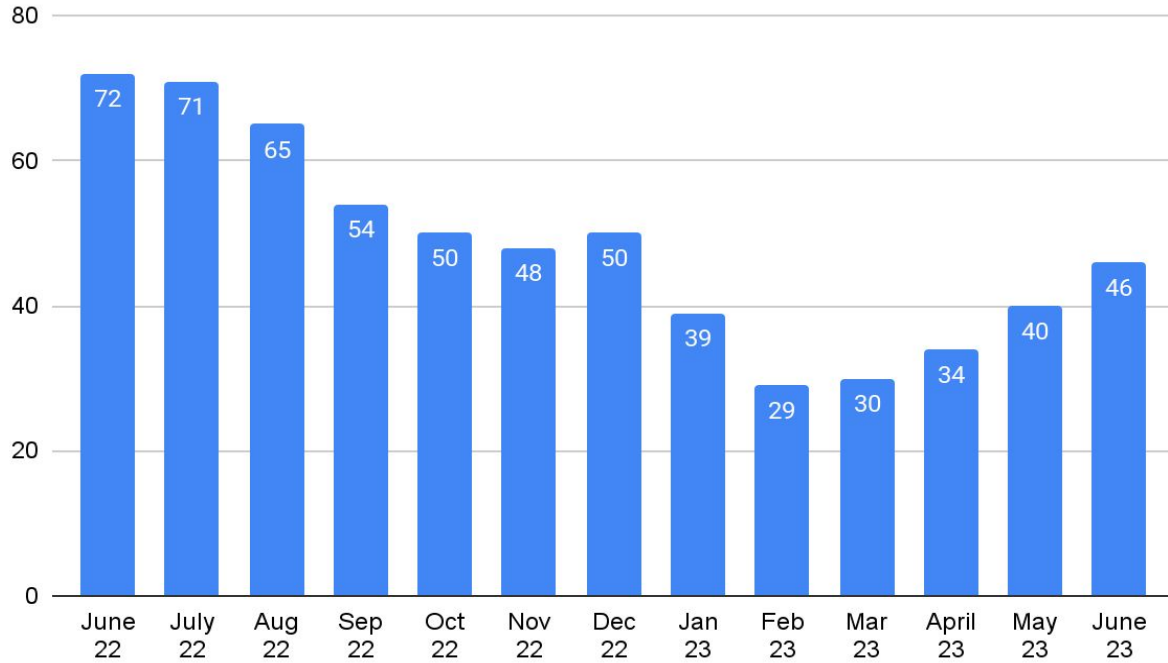

Number of Billed Cases By Month June 2022 - June 2023





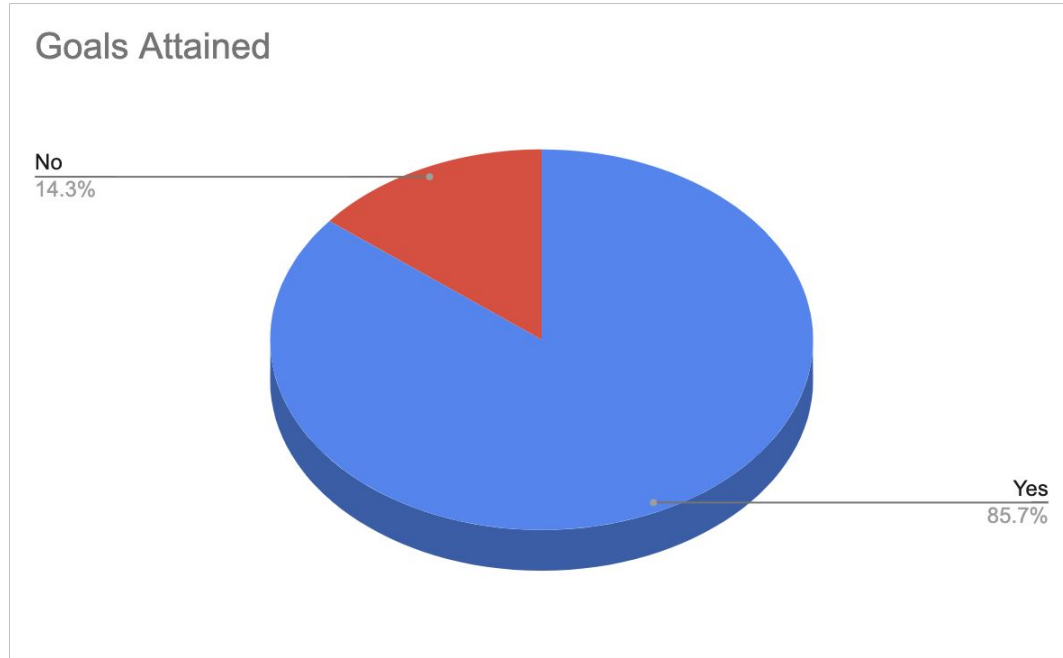

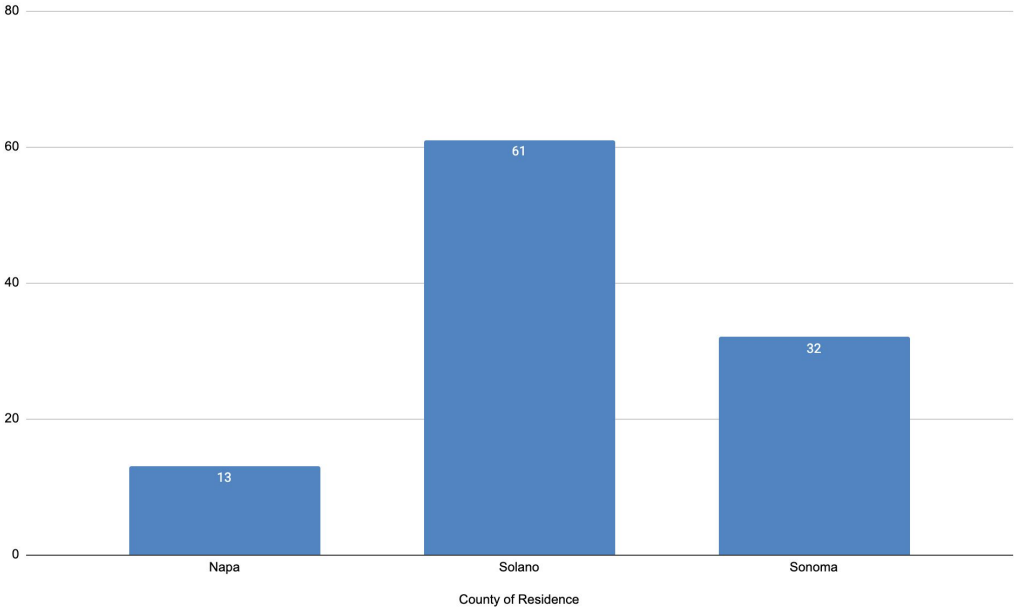

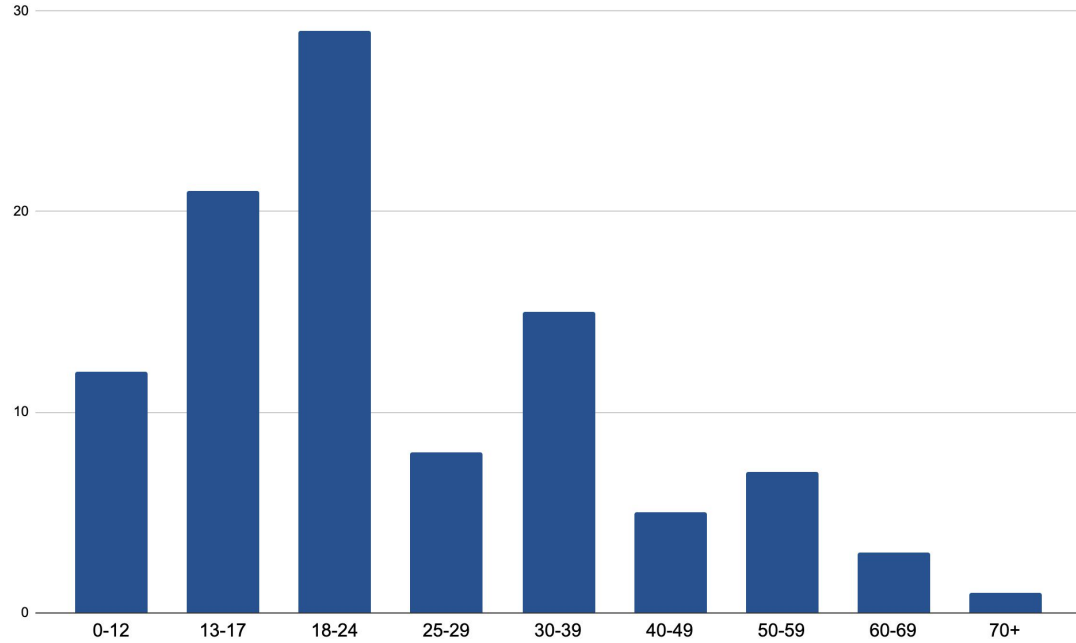


County of Residence June 2022 - June 2023

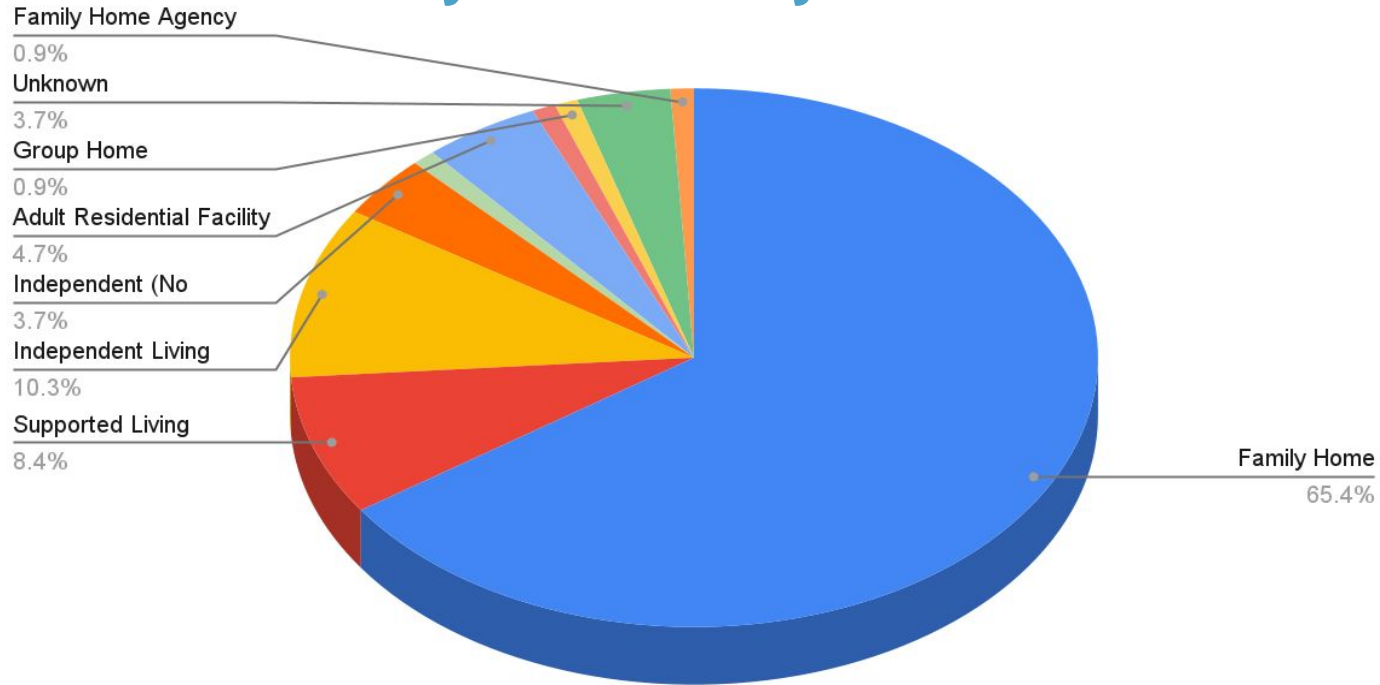


Age Demographics

Type of Living Environment June 2022 - June 2023

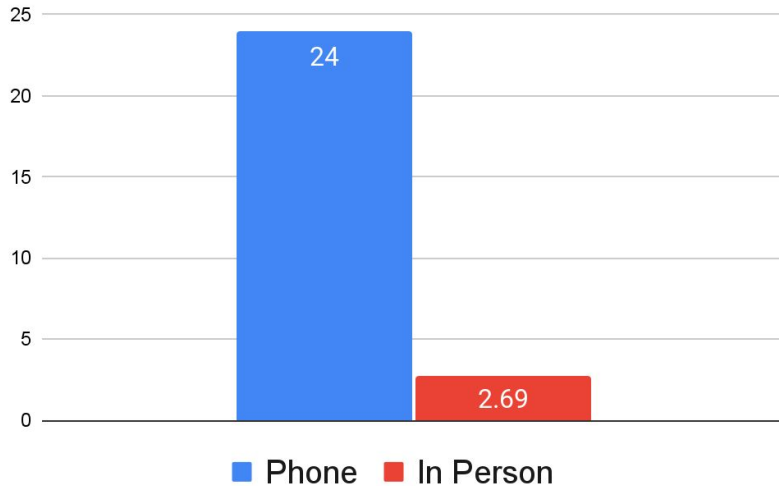

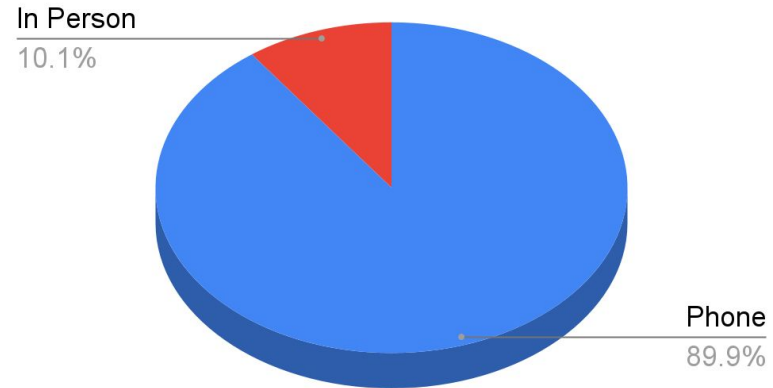

Average Crisis Responses per Month



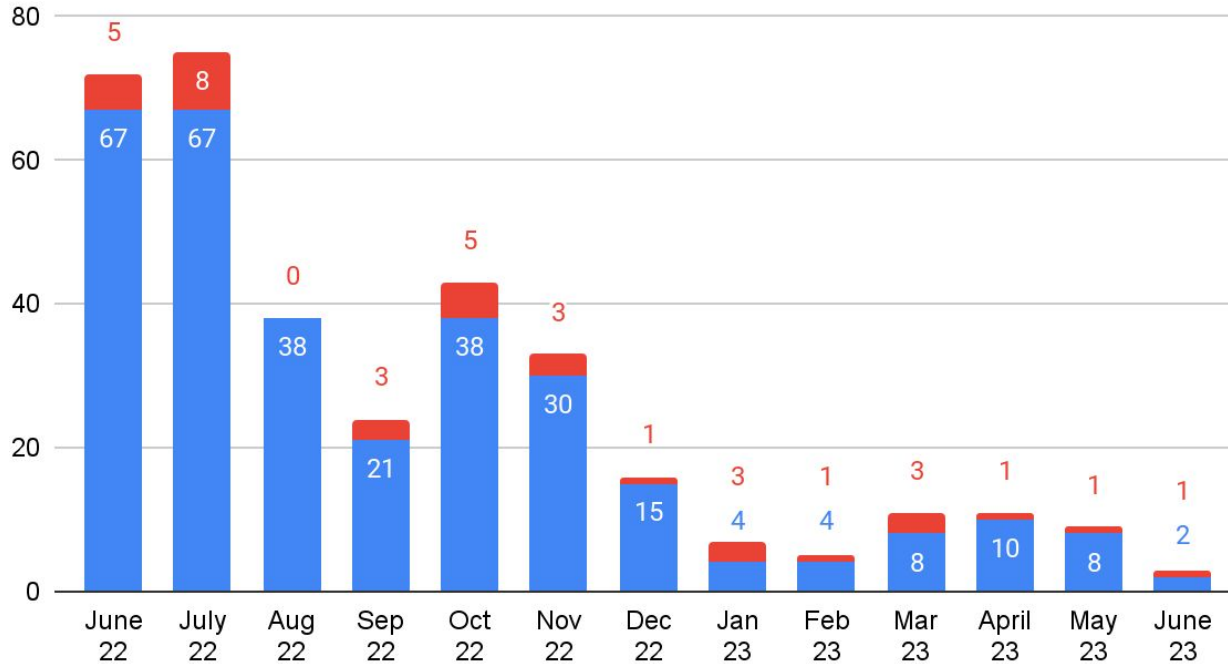
Crisis Response Delivery
