- Surveys & gift cards are distributed following the meeting.

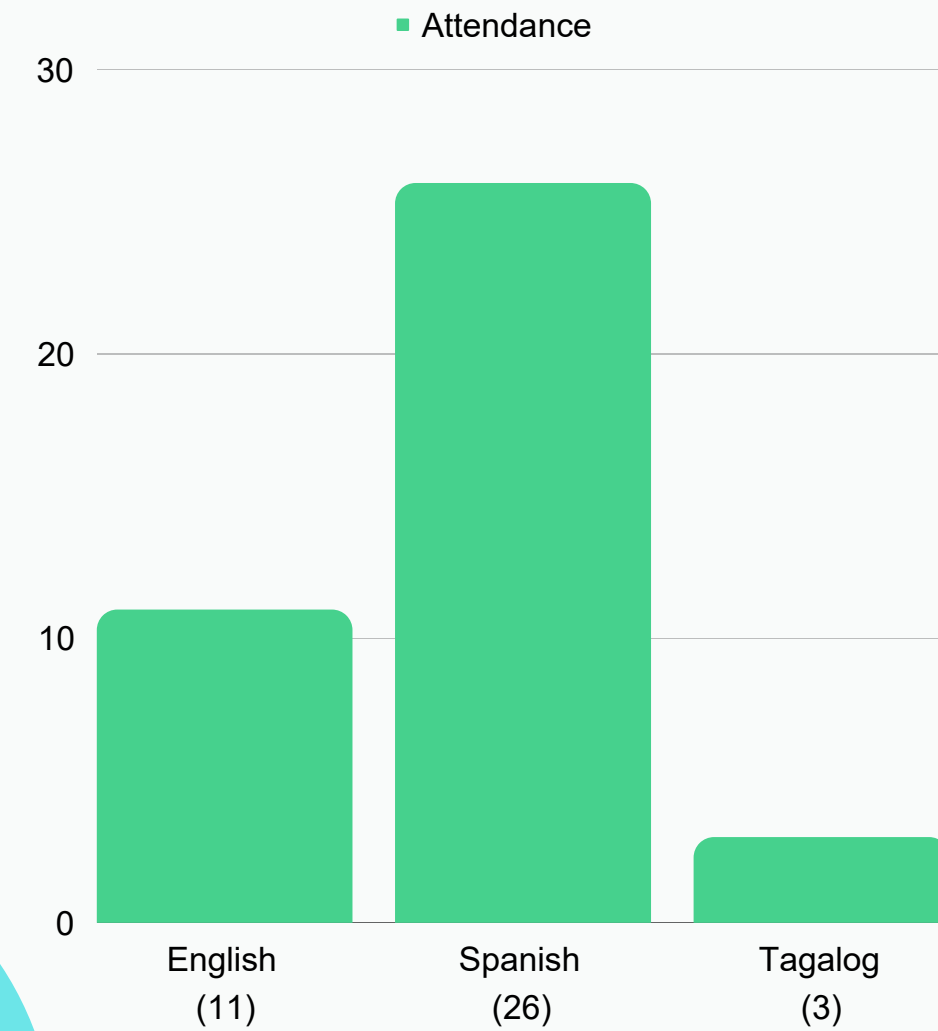
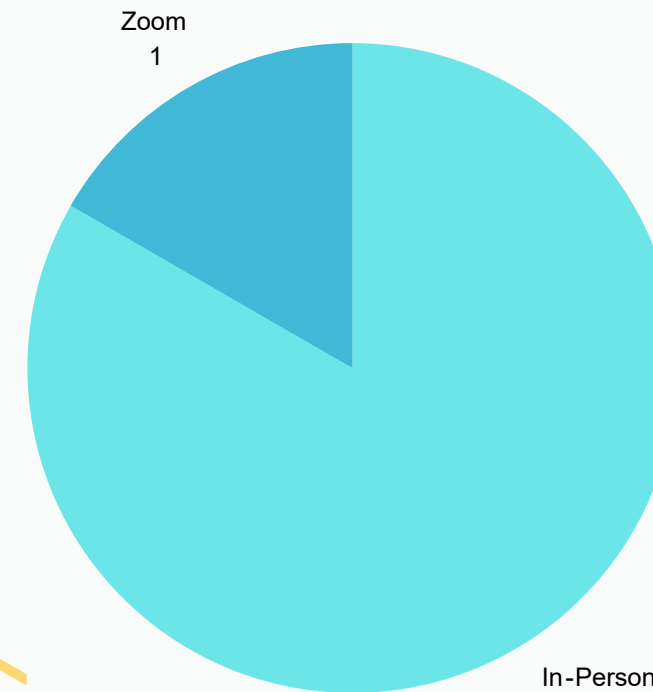

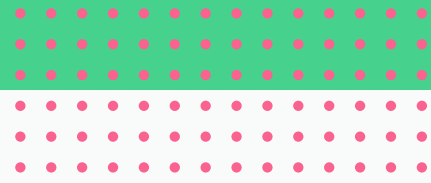
Support Workshop Series
